

Capacity Building Training for Civil Judges Begins at FJA

Islamabad: A one- week capacity building training course for Civil Judges was formally inaugurated at the Federal Judicial Academy (FJA) Phase-11 Building on April 22, 2019.

During training programme, 26 participants will also have Syndicate Discussion, Group Presentations, Study Circle on " Qanoon-e-Shahadat Order, 1984", Practical Exercise on ADR, Mock Trial-Putting it in Practice, Academy Night and Special Dinner.
