

National Conference on “Expeditious Justice Initiative” to be held at

Federal Academy on April 13

Islamabad: A one-day National Conference on “Expeditious Justice Initiative” is going to be held here at the Federal Judicial Academy Phase – II Building on April 13, 2019.

The inaugural and concluding sessions will be chaired by the Hon’ble Chief Justice of Pakistan, Mr. Justice Asif Saeed Khan Khosa who is also chairman, Board of Governors of the Academy.

Over 300 participants are expected to attend this unique sensitization and awareness generating national conference. Those who will attend the conference include: Chief Justices of provincial High Courts, District and Sessions Judges, Judges of the newly-established “Model Criminal Trial Courts”, Provincial Health Secretaries, Prosecutor Generals of the provinces, Inspector Generals of Police, Inspector Generals of Prisons, prosecutors, investigation officers, among others.
